## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE (adults & children over 12 years):**

Take one to two tablets with a large glass of water.

Repeat dose every six hours, as required, up to a maximum of 8 tablets in 24 hours.

MAXIGESIC can also be dissolved in a glass of water, if required.

Do NOT take MAXIGESIC with other products containing paracetamol, ibuprofen, aspirin or other anti-inflammatory medicines.

Adults: Do not take MAXIGESIC for more than a few days at a time unless advised to by a doctor.

Children and adolescents 12 years+: Do not take MAXIGESIC for more than 48 hours at a time unless advised to by a doctor.
